

1. $6 \times 2 \times 4 = 48$
2. $8 \times 10 \times 6 = 480$
3. $4 \times 9 \times 5 = 180$

4. $4 \times 2 \times 30 = 240$
5. $3 \times 50 \times 3 = 450$
6. $60 \times 2 \times 4 = 480$

7. $24 \times 5 \times 2 = 240$
8. $2 \times 85 \times 3 = 510$
9. $32 \times 3 \times 4 = 384$

Challenge:

Viv, Alex and Ria are trying to work out $43 \times 2 \times 5$.

Viv says she would work out 43×2 and then $\times 5$.

Alex says he would work out 43×5 and then $\times 2$.

Ria says she would work out 2×5 and then $\times 43$.

Ria's method is easiest because we know 2×5 is 10 and 43×10 is also straight forward so we know that the answer to $43 \times 2 \times 5 = 430$.
