What is the Junior Leadership Team?

The Junior Leadership Team, or JLT, is the new name for the School Council. It includes two children from each class. They meet often to express their views and make decisions about different issues.

Elections

Each year, in the elections, pupils vote, using a ballot paper, for the candidate who they think will represent their class the best. This is a democratic decision.

Ballot Paper

- Before voting, please read the following:
- Vote once for one person.
 - Place one 'X' only on this ballot paper beside the name of the candidate you have chosen.
 - Do not write or mark anything else on the ballot paper; if you do, your paper will be invalid and your vote will not be counted.
 - When you have marked the ballot paper, fold the paper and place it in the box provided.
