“Your dinner’s ready,” said Bernard’s mother.

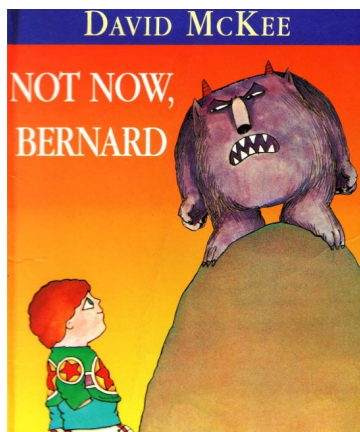
She put the dinner in front of the television. The monster ate the dinner.
